

Teen Camp Code of Conduct

It is the policy and purpose of the New Jersey YM-YWHA Camps that every member of the Teen Camp community has an excellent camp experience in a safe and healthy environment where its membership, which includes staff, campers and his/her parents, treat each other with mutual respect. This respect extends to every person, his/her belongings, the camp and its property.

To ensure that every member of the Teen Camp community has this positive experience, consistent with the policy and purpose stated above, all Teen Campers must abide by this Code of Conduct.

1. Use or possession of alcohol or illegal drugs will not be tolerated at any time during the camp season either on camp property, off grounds or on a camp sanctioned trip.
2. Sexual contact, meaning conduct deemed unacceptable in public places, will not be tolerated at any time during the camp season either on camp property, off campgrounds or on a camp sanctioned trip.
3. Camper must adhere to the Electronics, Cell Phone and Digital Camera Policy. Please see attached.
4. Teen campers are not allowed in the living quarters of the opposite sex, either on camp property, off campgrounds or on camp sanctioned trips. This includes, but is not limited to bunks, tents, and hotel/motel rooms.
5. Teen campers must participate in camp activities. This includes regularly scheduled and elective activities.
6. Teen campers are to be in assigned activity areas and shall be inside his/her own bunk by curfew.
7. Possession of cigarettes, cigars, pipes or chewing tobacco by Teen Campers is prohibited either in camp, off campgrounds or on camp sanctioned trips. If such tobacco products are found, they will be confiscated.
8. Possession of fireworks or any type of knife by Teen Campers in camp is prohibited. If found, items will be confiscated.

Violation of the above Teen Camper Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action, which may include, expulsion or loss of privileges including trips and banquets, and parent notification. Violation of #1 or #2 shall result in automatic expulsion for the duration of the summer.
